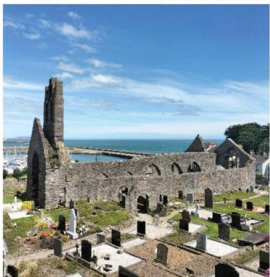
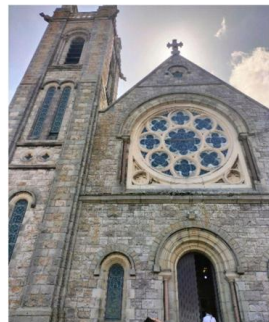
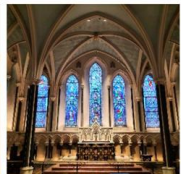


Dublin and Ireland
